CMAS (Colorado Measures of Academic Success) assessment time is rapidly approaching. CMAS is the state testing that all students in our district and state are required to take. This includes students in 3rd through 8th grades. This assessment measures the growth of our student's standards mastery in literacy, math and science. We will begin testing 6th - 8th grade students the week of March 19th. Students will test in literacy on the 20th - 22nd of March. 3rd-5th students will test in literacy will the week of April 2nd. Math testing will begin the following week for 3-8th grade students and Science testing will begin the week of April 16th for 5th and 8th grade students only.

It is imperative that students be present for all tests. Please do not plan any doctor or dentist appointments during this time.
